READING	Group 1 of Jolly Phonics Look at the cover of a book. Make a prediction about what you think the story is about. Look at the pictures. Make a prediction about what you think will happen. Read the book with an adult.	Group 2 of Jolly Phonics Read a book with an adult. Point along with the words. Try sounding out words you don't know. Talk about new words.	Group 3 of Jolly Phonics Read a story with an adult. Can you find some sight words? Draw your favourite part of the story. *Story and sight words provided in resources	Group 4 of Jolly Phonics Ask an adult to read you a story. Listen to it carefully, then retell the story to your adult. Draw your favourite character.
ENGLISH	Read a rhyming story. Listen for the rhyming words (words that have the same ending sound). Say the rhyming words. *Rhyming story provided in resources	Rhyming words – say the 3 words in the group. Which ones rhyme? *Word groups list provided in resources	Practice writing letters! You can use a pencil, crayon, paint OR you can use a stick and write them in the dirt or sand. Use the alphabet chart to help you. *Alphabet chart provided in resources	Pick a word from the word groups list. How many rhyming words can you think of? Have a go at writing them!
MATHS	Colour scavenger hunt! How many items around home can you find of these colours? -Red -Pink -Blue -Orange -Green -Grey	Practice writing numbers! You can use a pencil, crayon, paint OR you can use a stick and write them in the dirt or sand.
